ISO 9002 CERTIFIED SYSTEMS STAY

Congratulations Accu-Fab Team!!!!

On November 28, 2001 Accu-Fab successfully completed another regularly scheduled ISO 9002 surveillance audit by Intertek Service Corporation. ISO Certified status was, of course maintained; with only three minor system deficiencies being identified. Proof of a continuing focus on improvement and a consistent decrease in number of system deficiencies identified from past audits.

One point of particular success involved ISO implementation for the Can-Do Tooling division acquired August 1, 2001. Accu-Fab moved Can-Do's machining operations on site in Raleigh September 3, 2001 and passed the ISO audit in less than 90 days.

Accu-Fab's next surveillance audit scheduled for April will also be a preassessment audit for the ISO 9000/2000 standards with formal certification scheduled for 4th quarter this year.
